2022-2023 High School Guidelines

Community Service Learning (CSL) is an educational process, which enhances the quality of life within the school and the community. Community Service Learning combines instruction, 21st Century Skills, and voluntary participation in supporting activities or obtaining contributions of goods.



Students in the classes of 23, 24, and 25 will need 50 hours and students in the classes of 26 and beyond will need 80 hours upon graduation to earn the service seal. Students may receive credit for activities completed the summer prior to the 9th grade as long as it aligns with the guidelines included here.

What Qualifies?

These are just guidelines to what counts. Please check with your teacher to verify any hours:

- Activities that benefit the school or community
- * Non-Profit Organizations
- * Activities that serve individuals who cannot otherwise provide for themselves

What **DOES NOT** Qualify?

The activities below can still be used on college applications, but will not earn points for the county seal:

- * Religious activities involving education, evangelism, or worship.
- * Activities tied to a grade or other type of compensation.
- * Court related Community Service.

Furthermore, please keep in mind of the location of the service activities. Parents should always know where their child will be when doing.
